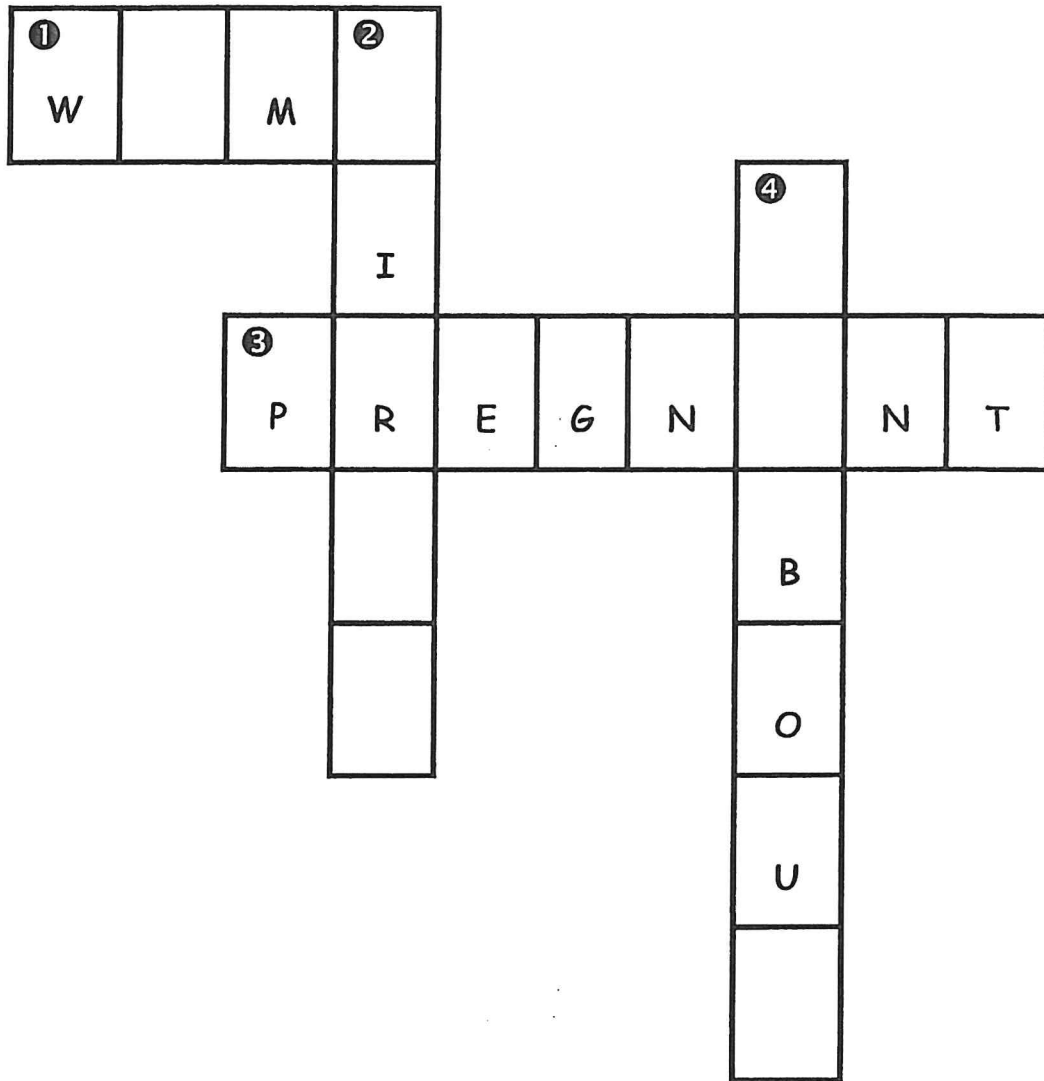


## Lesson 5 Worksheet


