A Policy for Supervision

The Primary aim of supervision is to ensure safety, at all times, for all of the children.

Supervision is provided from 8.10 am until 8.45 in the Breakfast Club and from 8.45 am until 3.00 pm each day.

At 8.45 am each teacher supervises the arrival of children in his/her class.

At break time the children are supervised by the teachers on duty and the classroom assistants in the playground or classrooms as appropriate.

Lunch time supervision is carried out by supervisory assistants and classroom assistants.

Teachers will collect their classes promptly from the playground after break and lunch.

All children, will be supervised by the teachers as children are collected at the designated pick up points by parent/guardian.

There is a rota of Classroom assistants or teachers on bus duty.

Pupils attending after school activities are met at their respective club areas by teachers. At the end of activities (4.00) children are escorted to a designated pick up point.
